Diagram of locomotive footplate controls and their use (based on L.N.E.R Class V2)

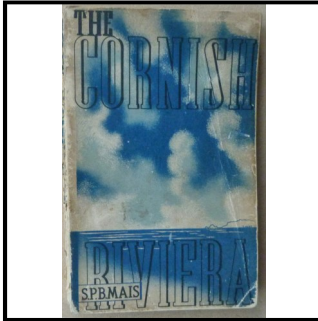
